9.15 PANEL 1 Origin and objectives of the URMA project: urban-rural partnership project

International exchange of experience in the realisation and exploration of urban-rural partnerships at different scales is one of the objectives of the project URMA. This approach allows to understand the essence of URMA partnerships: their definition, purpose and development potential which provide spatially varying associations created by local governments. Recommendations for the European Commission, developed during the project, indicate the need for institutional support of urban-rural partnerships as an instrument of multiscale regional policy. Using of the project results is possible at the level of supra-regional and regional level, metropolitan and local level. The idea of urban-rural partnership was developed in the framework of the activities organized by the association of cities and regions - METREX.

11.00 PANEL2 Pilot projects

URMA pilot projects are related to the issues of urban-rural partnerships in different scales and conditions specific for each region. The City of Hamburg attempted to build a new urban-rural cooperation in macro-scale: Germany, Denmark, Sweden. Region of Lombardy analyzed approach to urban-rural partnership in conjunction with EXPO 2015 challenge constraints and organize the space exposed to suburbanisation of Milan, the Dutch region of Twente (Enschede municipality) regional co-founded the food chain as an innovative way to build urban-rural relations. West Pomerania implements spatial modeling study on the example of the suburban village Wołczkowo village in the Dobra municipality and Guidelines for the Integrated Development Strategy of the Central Functional Zone of Westpomeranian Voviodeship.
